Faculty Position in Experimental Particle Physics

The Harvard University Department of Physics plans to make a tenure track assistant professor appointment in experimental particle or experimental astro-particle physics. A more senior appointment to full professor may be made for exceptional candidates.

The present experimental particle physics program consists of groups working on CDF at Fermilab, BABAR at SLAC, the MINOS experiment at Fermilab/Soudan, the ATLAS Experiment at CERN and on experiments in observational cosmology. Applicants for the position should have postdoctoral experience with demonstrated ability in instrumentation and analysis, and should have a demonstrable aptitude for teaching. Applications from or nominations of women and minority candidates are strongly encouraged.

The position has the nominal starting date of July 2006, but an earlier starting date could be arranged. Applications, including curriculum vitae, a statement of interest and three letters of recommendation should be sent before December 15, 2005 to:
